




To keep the date all on one line, we may need to reduce the font slightly





This would allow the member to print out the round rules to have in front of them as they participate and not require them to constantly refer back to their mobile device.




the **user** needs the ability to crop their uploaded photo and have it fit within a 2 x 3 target box format




**In the same live weekly challenge flow,**

**Host sign up flow for entering a target image.**


The current cropping tool needs adjustment to allow for it to fit a 2(w) x 3(h) window proportion.

This needs to allow the user to crop the image






**Host sign up flow for entering their payment information.**

The box header should read "Expiration Date" and not "ExpirationDate"




**Live weekly leaderboard / Championship leaderboard / Host leaderboard**




If a man enters the men's division and posts a result, it is showing on both the mens leaderboard and the womens. Should only be shown on the mens


If a women enters the womens division and posts a result, it is showing on both the mens and womends leaderboard. Should only be shown on the womens.




### Host Profile from the Menu tab

When a host signs up, in their payment detail, it does not show the amount paid for the host event fee and the date







The top box should be showing what the hosting fee is which should be \$100 as set in the super admin. This is what we are charging to use the platform / event So pull the host event cost and not the RAF subscription cost w/targets Remove the second box showing Hosts event fee as this is not applicable to this flow. And have the CC image represent what was used prior of Host Event Fee (USD) / Event @ 100.00




This box design is correct, but the amount should be \$100 as pulled from the super admin on the cost / event to host







note that the W does not fit in the box and how the action button is hidden - move all of the elements on the page up to avoid scrolling

and when they click on the action button, it takes them to the event library and on this page, none of the bottom icons are accessible. They should be as they are now a active host







Need the same functionality on a Member Password box with an "Eye" to open (see) the password




Keep the routing number requirement at 9 digits but do not put a requirement on the account number as these can vary from 8-17 digits




The example I created was I had a guest sign in to a hosted event and paid their subscription so they were now a member, I then had them select to create their own event code which generated the above error CC page. Once they were done and received their event code, I logged out and logged back in and it did not give access to the host admin portal. When a person is a host and member and signs in, take them to the main landing page (VS dashboard as per a host only login) but provide access to the host admin portal and features.

I created a member account and then created a host account and received a host code. When logged in using the persons email and password (which are the same for both) only the member profile was showing







If a person is a member and also a host, their landing page should only have one box option and that is to sign up to join your hosts private group challenge



a person who is both a member and host should only see this box




If a person is ONLY a host, it is currently allowing them to participate in the Live Raf Challenges they should get an error directing them to sign up to participate in the RAF live Challenges







I went in and changed the end date to a date past and the data did move to the completed events section, but the main dashboard did not update correctly in the Live events section

On the above image, Rev-Share Members, This is a bit confusing to explain but let me attempt:

When a host creates an event and lets say tha there are 100 new RAF members, This is currently being shown correctly in the live events section, and in the completed events section. Once an event completes, RAF will be paying the host for all the event fee's collected AND the initial new RAF membership (the first month of the members subscription) from the event sign up. When a new member pays the 2nd, 3rd. Etc month consecutively, the programming logic will be. 1), Member email, check to see if that email is attached to a host code - if Yes then add 1 to the Rev-Share Member total in that month and add the revenue at (sub cost x .20). So depending on the event end date, this number will grow over the first month to a max of the amount of new sub. members that attended the event.




So for this example, the number should be 0.

In the Rev-Share Members section under a months detail, the New RAF Initial should be 1 in this example. The remaining will follow the rules listed above.

There is a small issue with the live Events section. Again, any event that has a start date and an end date that is not passed (completed) is to be included and shown in the detail of the Live Events Section. I created an event with a start date of 11/09 (future) and it is showing on the dashboard, but not in the detail as it should. See below.

Also, I can tell that the rev-share calculation is wrong. As stated multiple times, the rev-share is ONLY calculated using the BASE subscription amount (\$9.00) and NEVER the subscription + targets. It is pulling over \$5.00 which is the 20% of \$25 which is wrong!




The flow for editing Events from the dashboard section is great - much better. The only programming issue is if someone selects any of the pages from the top list to go to that page, we should have a button on the bottom that is Highlighted for "Edit", and the "Save Changes" should be dimmed.

If they select Edit, than the Edit should go dimmed and the Save Changes highlighted.


If they click Edit and then choose Close page, then the current error message is appropriate,  
If they do not click Edit and only click Close Page, then no error message is appropriate.

Having the Save changes highlighted without any editing being done or requested to be done is not intuitive.

So I'm looking for three buttons across the bottom and not just the two shown on each of the pages in the Edit Event tab as selected from the top row in edit event


The Save Changes box dimmed / inactive unless the Edit button is pressed.

If the first button pressed is close page, then no error message and return user to event library event as is currently programmed.

then the Close page is pressed – the error message to the right should present.





### All leaderboards

The leaderboard that a member is to be displayed on is first determined by if they enter in the Women's or Men's division as the first sort and then by the the pistol division chosen.

The toggle(s) in the RAF or Host event creation for Mens or womens divisions are only to limit if that division is available.

**Currently each member is showing on both the Mens and womens which is incorrect**



A member can have multiple leaderboard posts if they enter multiple divisions (not mens and womens - but different pistol divisions)



If someone signs into a hosted event and completes the event and the host has not selected the toggle to allow multiple attempts, the error message preventing this should be from the page where they select to enter the event or view the leaderboard and not from the initial signing in. They do need access to the event details and leaderboard, just not to do the event a second time.

**The championship leaderboard(s) have issues with the dates. This is how they are designed to work.**


**The summary (podium only by division) show at the top for Week ending Date of the Sunday of each progressive week. For example for the challenges starting last week of November 04 (each weeks challenges start on a Monday - not Sunday) thru Nov 10th (Sunday is the end date of each weeks challenges). So the end date for Week Ending Date is November 10th (Sunday).**



**So at the stroke of midnight on each Sunday, the system is to close that weeks challenge ranking. That challenge is done and results are sealed.**

**Note that the challenge leaderboard does not contain or show the current live leaderboard as it is a trailing leaderboard. This is why there is a live and a championship**

**To determine the rankings for the championship leaderboard as the stroke of midnight each week, we are to take the scores across the prior 8 weeks and total each members scores for each challenge that they provided a score (by pistol division and by mens / womens division) and this will be their championship leaderboard ranking.**

**These will be shown on the summary as well as by division.**








Note on the second division that there are 3 podium positions but only one showing

Make this fit without the need for vertical scrolling.







at the bottom, It would be better if the copy on the pages did not go below this part of the screen when possible by moving everything up.








The credit card page is weird in that it jumps the screen around from area to area instead of just moving between fields and keeping the overall page stationary.










These were only a few examples so all the screens should be check for similar issues













