




When switching a host toggle from Active to InActive, provide a popup saying "Are you sure you want to make this Host InActive? With Cancel and Yes as the options. Once Yes is pressed, the Host toggle should be switched off and the host should not be shown on the list. It will only be accessable by changing the search status to Inactive.



This number is taken from when a participant signs up into a host's event through the Sign up for a hosts private event flow or through the sponsors event flow. This is the time at which they acquire the event code. The number of new RAF members from host's events - remaining is looking through that list of members tied to a each host and verifying that they are "Active". If "Active" than they should be included and only drop off once they become "InActive" by canceling their subscription.






Provide for a search button so that an event code can be searched for. When we have hundreds, it will be hard to find an exact one easily without such functionality.




After a target zone is selected, it needs to be dimmed and unavailable for selection for additional rounds. same way we did this in the user host sign up flow.




- Clear Content

This is in the manage members view detail page. Change out the Transaction ID to the date that the subscripton was created or renewed.




Delete the drop down arrows from this "View" page, but provide for a way to "open" to view the Bio as this could be very lengthly and not fit or viewed easliy on one line.
